- b) "The book/TV series 'The Handmaid's Tale' is based on the secretive religious group, People of Praise, to which the recently confirmed Supreme Court Justice Amy Coney Barrett belongs."
- c) "Joe Biden is mentally unfit to be the U.S. President."
- d) "Mail-in ballots cause voter fraud."
- e) "The proposed Biden/Harris insurance reform will eliminate private health insurance plans for over 180 million people."

Methodology

This is the fifth of a six-part series of reports tracking the diffusion of misinformation in the 2020 U.S. presidential election campaign period. Data in this wave were collected from an online panel of American adults, recruited by Qualtrics. Data were collected from 27 October to 2 November 2020. The sample size was 564 (margin of error $\approx 4\%$). Forty seven percent of participants were female. The average age was 46.5 (SD = 16.6), with a range of 18 to 85. The sample was 60.8% white, 12.7% Black, and 11.7% Latina/Latino.
